RESPECT OTHERS

This means:

This means:

- Come prepared for each class

BE HELPFUL

This means:

- Learn from your mistakes
- Don't interfere with others' work
- Clean up after yourself
- Call school if you are not coming
- Eat and drink only when and where allowed
- Be a good role model for others
- Volunteer your time to help others
- Wear clean shoes inside

SHOW UP

This means:

- Attend school every day unless excused
- Arrive on time for each class
- Be there when you say you will

- Come rested and ready to learn

OBEY RULES

This means:

- Follow class, playground, bus & lunchroom rules
- Get office permission to leave the school
- Don't enter halls 'til proper bell has sounded
- Accept responsibility for your actions and words
- Dress appropriately for school

- leave outdoor coats in your locker
- clothing with pictures & messages appropriate for school
- take off head coverings in class
- wear clean shoes inside
- no suggestive, provocative or revealing clothing

- Electronic devices turned off and kept in lockers
- No skateboards, scooters, inline skates etc. to be used in school
- Cell phones turned off and not used in class

ACT SAFELY

- No sticks, rocks or snowballs
- Stay in designated areas
- Don't run inside
- Don't bring dangerous things to school
- Treat safety drills seriously
- No smoking, no illegal drugs or alcohol
- No smoking on school grounds
